
Dr. Betsy Baker - IARC Affiliate Faculty; Wilson Center Polar Institute Global Fellow

Dr. Saitoh will present on the ongoing work of the Working Group on Integrated Ecosystem Assessment for the Central Arctic Ocean (WGICA) which aims to provide a holistic analysis of present and future ecosystem and human activities in the Central Arctic Ocean. Dr. Baker will address the relevance for marine ecosystems and marine scientific activity of the 2018 Central Arctic Ocean Fisheries Agreement and the recently agreed text of the High Seas Treaty on Biodiversity Beyond National Jurisdiction.
